

THE INDIAN CLASSICAL INSTRUMENT

The Indian culture has present information about countless musical instruments. A Musical instruments is a device to make or to produce a sound. There is a brief history of the Indian classical music. In since in 200BC and 200AD according to the "Natya Shastra" written by the "Bharat Muni," he clubbed the musical instruments into Four groups

- -Avanaddha Vadya (Membranophones or percussion instruments)
- -Ghan Vaday- (IdoPhones or solid instrument)
- -Sushir Vadya (Aerophones or wind instrument)
- -Tat Vadya (Chordophones or stringed instrument)

In the Ancient Era Indian Statues and paintings showed the use of musical instruments similar to what we see today. As many different materials are used in the manufacturing process of the instrument including lether, animal skin, precious wood, metal etc. The making of the instruments required the great skill and also a basic knowledge of music and acoustical (Knowledge of Dhvanika) principles. Therefore, the musical instruments of India bring along a rich heritage and Indian culture and tradition of our country.

TABLA

In the since 18th Century it was in the "Avanaddha Vadya- the precession instrument or membranophone in Hindustani classical music, where it may be played as solo, as an accompaniment with other instrument (Sathsangat) and vocals and as large part of the ensembles. It is frequently played in popular and folk music, performance in India, Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Pakistan, Nepal, Shrilank, Arabians, Mesopotamians Etc.

The Theory based on the etymological links the word tabla to Arabic word tabl means "drum "The history of the tabla in India is from before the Mughal Empire from the Yadav's rule (1210-1247) in the south India.

In the various religions like in Hindu, Jain, Shik etc. The temple shows the Stone carvings of a person playing an instrument like a tabla small pair of drum-like instrument. In the pre 5th Century paintings and stone Carving in the Caves of Ajanta &Ellora caves located in (Ch.Sambajinagar Maharashtra) shows a group of musicians Playing a small. Tabla-like upright seated drum-like Instrument but carved in stone are found in ellora caves &in the caves of Arnala Located in the (Lonavala Maharashtra). The word tabla is formed in Serein Language and tabla comes from the three culture Mesopotamian, serein, Arabian from these culture with the mugal Empire the tabla instrument comes to India. In The 15th Century the sik First Guru-Nanak dev they introduce the tabla in beautiful sentence

According to the classification of musical instrument define in the NatyaShastra the tabla is classified in the Anandha Vadya it means that the instrument is made by the capping an empty vessel with a stretched skin of animal. The tabla is the instrument is essential instrument in the Bhakti, Bhajan, Kirtan, Khayal gayan, Dhrupad gayan, Tarna, gajal, qawali in Muslim culture, kathak it is the main rhythmic instrument in these all culture. The playing technique of the tabla is very complex and it involves the concentration extensive use of fingers and palms in various configuration to create the wide and the beautiful different sounds and the rhythms but the tabla instrument get an Everest height in the Indian Musical Culture it versatility in all musical styles has enabled it to become the most popular percussion instrument in all over India.

AYURVEDA: ANCIENT SCIENCE



• What is Ayurveda?

Ayurveda is an alternative medicine system with historical roots in the Indian subcontinent. It is the heavily practiced in India and Nepal, where around 80% of the population report using ayurveda. The theory and practice of Ayurveda is pseudoscientific.

• Principles of Ayurveda

- According to Ayurveda, health is defined as the balanced state of tridoshas, that is Vata, Pitta and Kapha in the body.
- This balanced state is responsible for the normal physiology of the body and health conditions of the mind.
 Ayurveda is based on the three fundamentals principles:
 - Panchamahabhuta Siddhanta
 - 2. Tridosha Siddhanta
 - 3. Guna Rasa Virya Vipaka Prabhav Siddhanta

• History of Ayurveda

•The evolution of the Indian art of healing and living a healthy life comes from the four Vedas namely: Rig Veda, Sama Veda, Yajur Veda and Atharva Veda.

Ayurveda attained a state of reverence and is classified as one of the Upa-Vedas - a subsection attached to the Atharva Veda.

- •The origin of Ayurveda could be roughly traces back to 5000 years old.
- •The Atharva Veda contains not only the magic spells and the occult sciences but also the Ayurveda that deals with the diseases, injuries, fertility, sanity and health.

The knowledge we have now is by three surviving texts of Charaka, Sushruta and Vaghbata.

• The benefits of Ayurveda


- An Ayurveda originated in India about five thousand years ago. Ayurveda is considered to have evolved from Atharva Veda, one of the four Vedas. The objective is to give the feeling of wellness, physically, mentally and spiritually. The basic concepts and fundamental principles aim at establishing such a condition through correct and thorough knowledge of healthy living.
- •A person can function normally only when his Doshas, Dhatus, Malas and Agni are in a state of equilibrium.

 A balance in the Trigunas helps to keep the mind clear of ill thoughts, fear and anger.
- An Ayurvedic approach to an illness is holistic and therefore after an Ayurvedic treatment a person wil find an improvement in their physical, mental and psychological conditions.
 - The ingredients used in Ayurvedic medicines are mostly derived from herbs, plants, flowers, fruits etc.



The Visit was mandatory to fulfil the curriculum requirement of Pharmacy students under subjects like social Pharmacy. The main aim of the visit is to acquaint the students with the process of municipal waste water treatment. In the beginning, Mr. Hemant Kashid briefed the students about 100MLD Tertiary Sewage Treatment Plant. He has made this session interesting by asking basic questions to the students. After the introduction, all students were divided into two groups of batches and were headed by one staff member of the respective program who helped them to understand the processes going in the plant. Mr Hemant Kashid has explained the functions of each unit of a preliminary, primary, secondary, and tertiary process. He explained the mechanism of UASB (Up-flow Anaerobic Sludge Blanket) and nutrients removal process including Nitrification, De-Nitrification, and Phosphorous removal processes. Sewage treatment is the process of removing contaminants from municipal wastewater, containing mainly household sewage plus some industrial wastewater.
