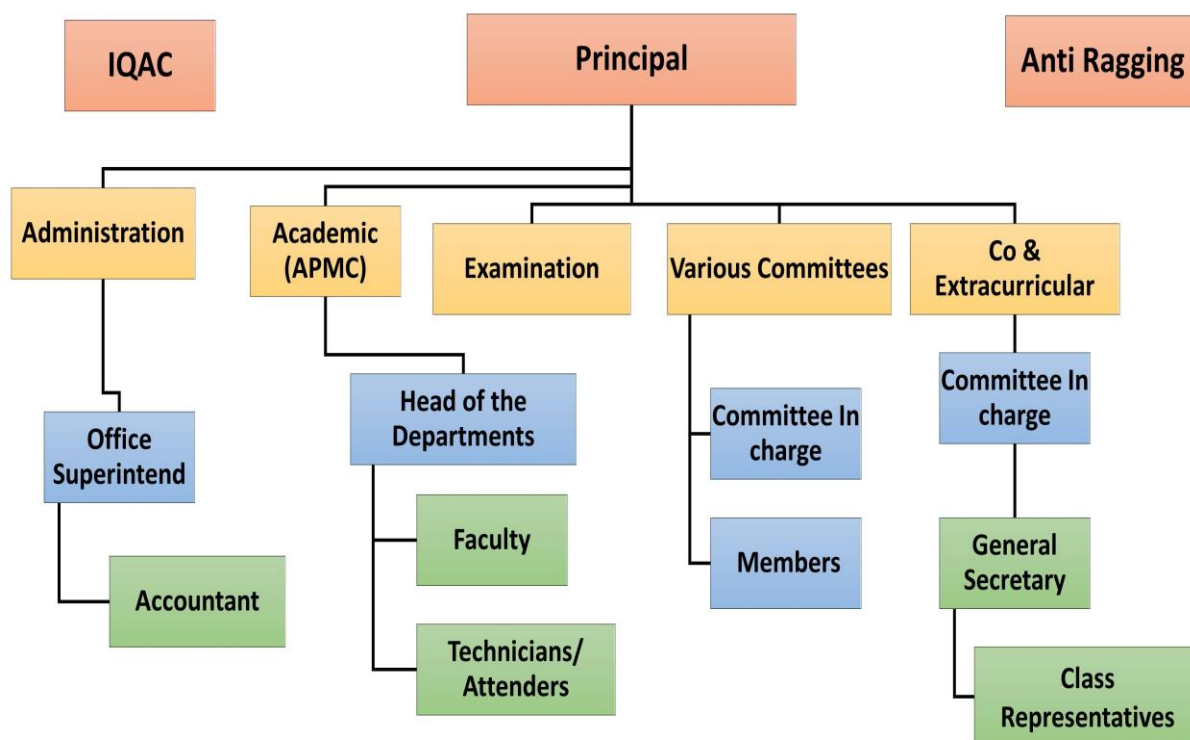

Decentralization of Work:

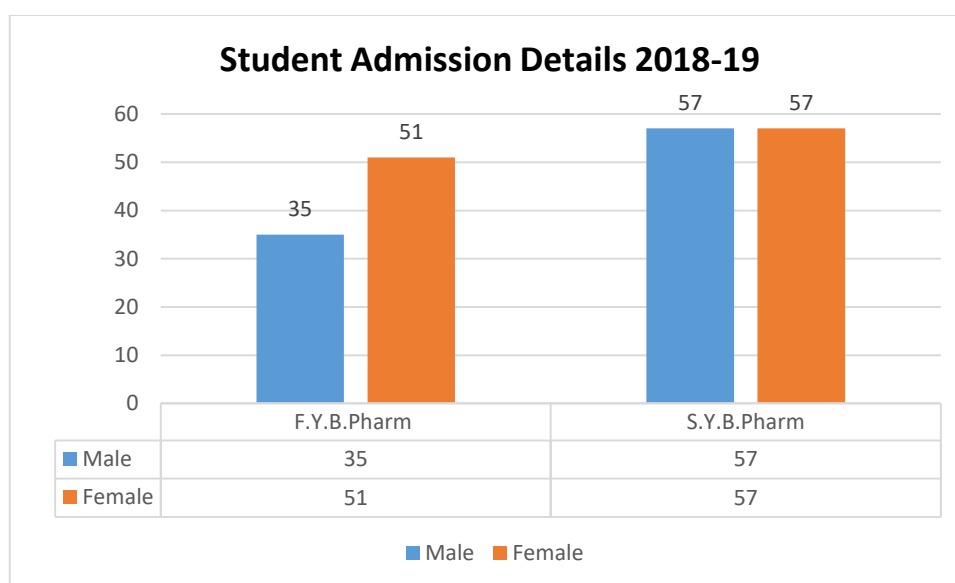

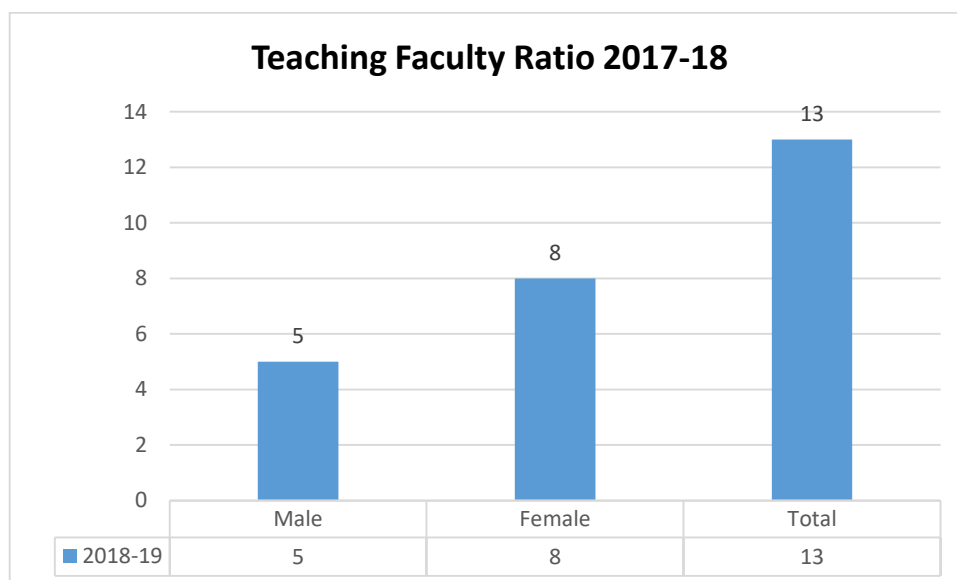
TEACHING FACULTY

College of Pharmacy is committed to maintaining high standards of education and ensuring the availability of proficient teaching faculty to impart quality learning experiences to its students.

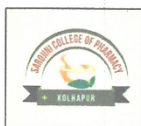
Teaching Faculty Information:

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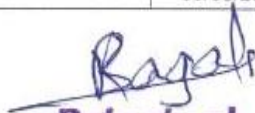

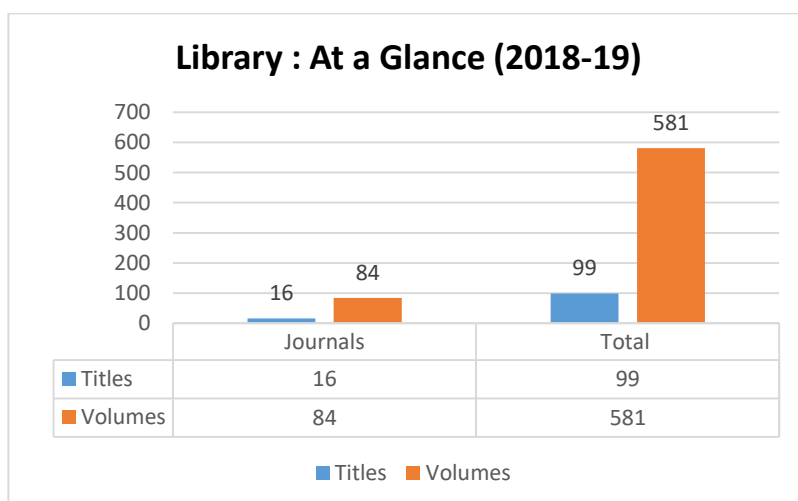

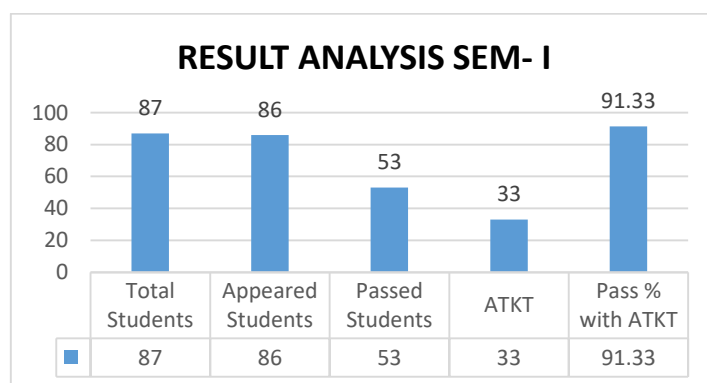


STUDENTS PERFORMANCE

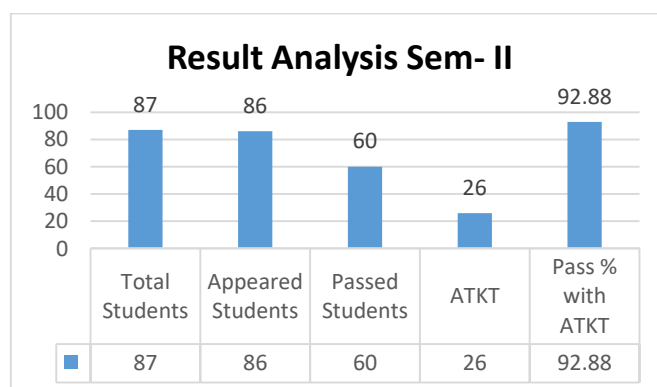

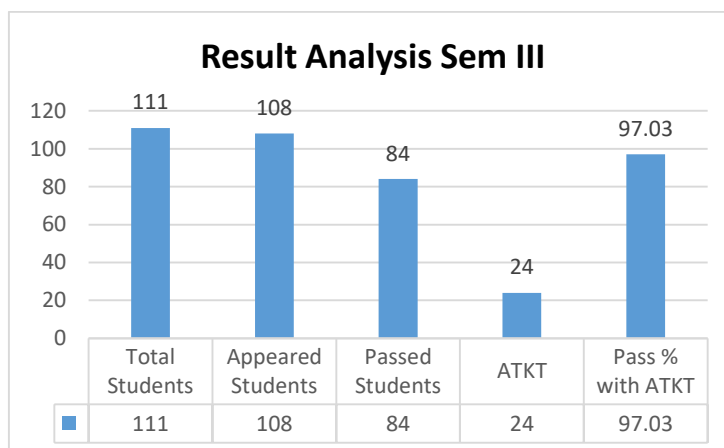
RESULT ANALYSIS SEMESTER- II

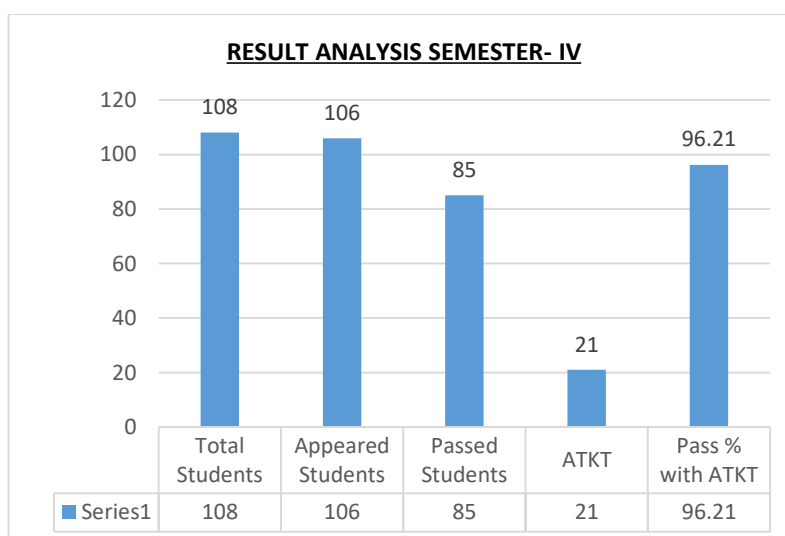

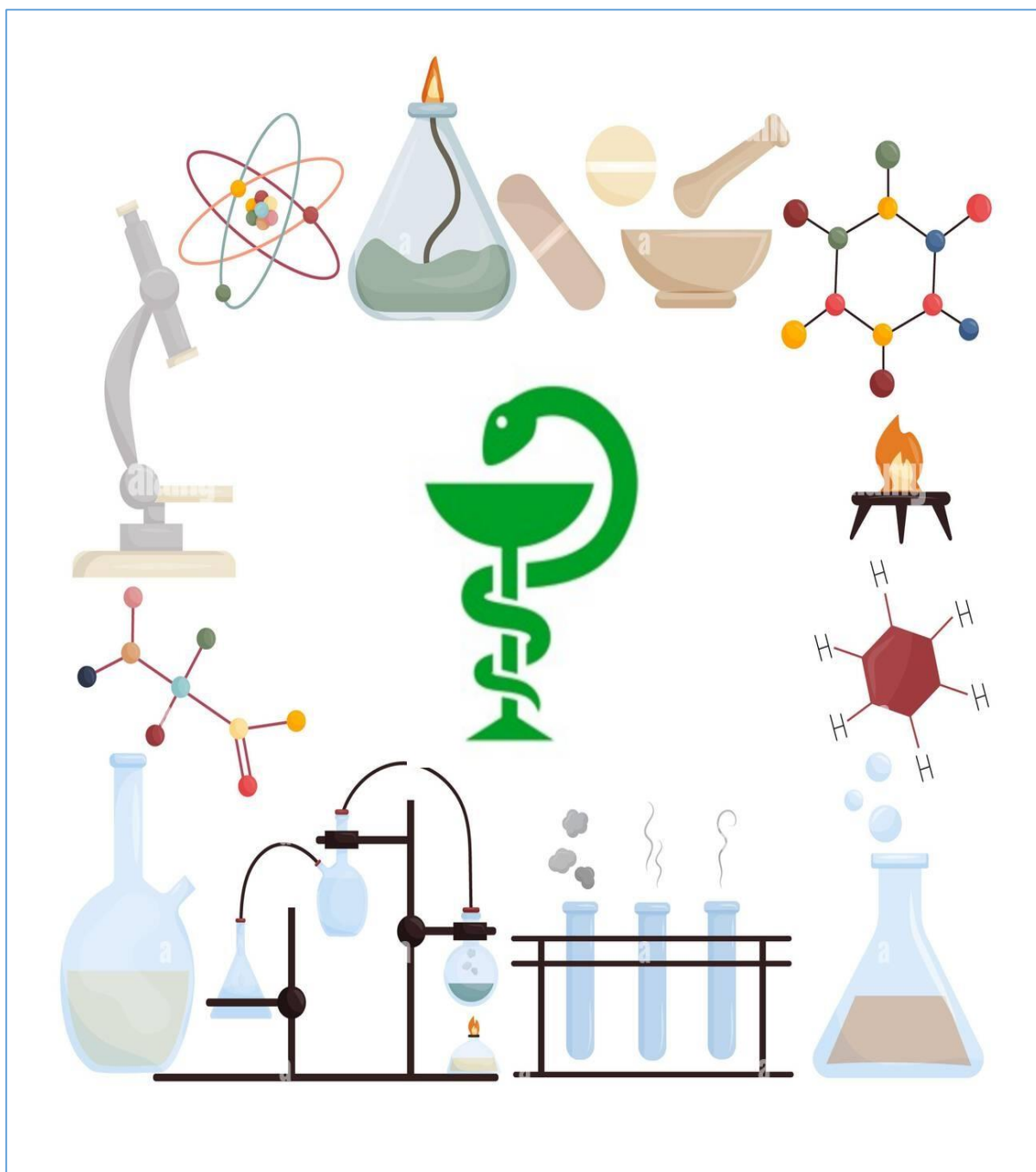
