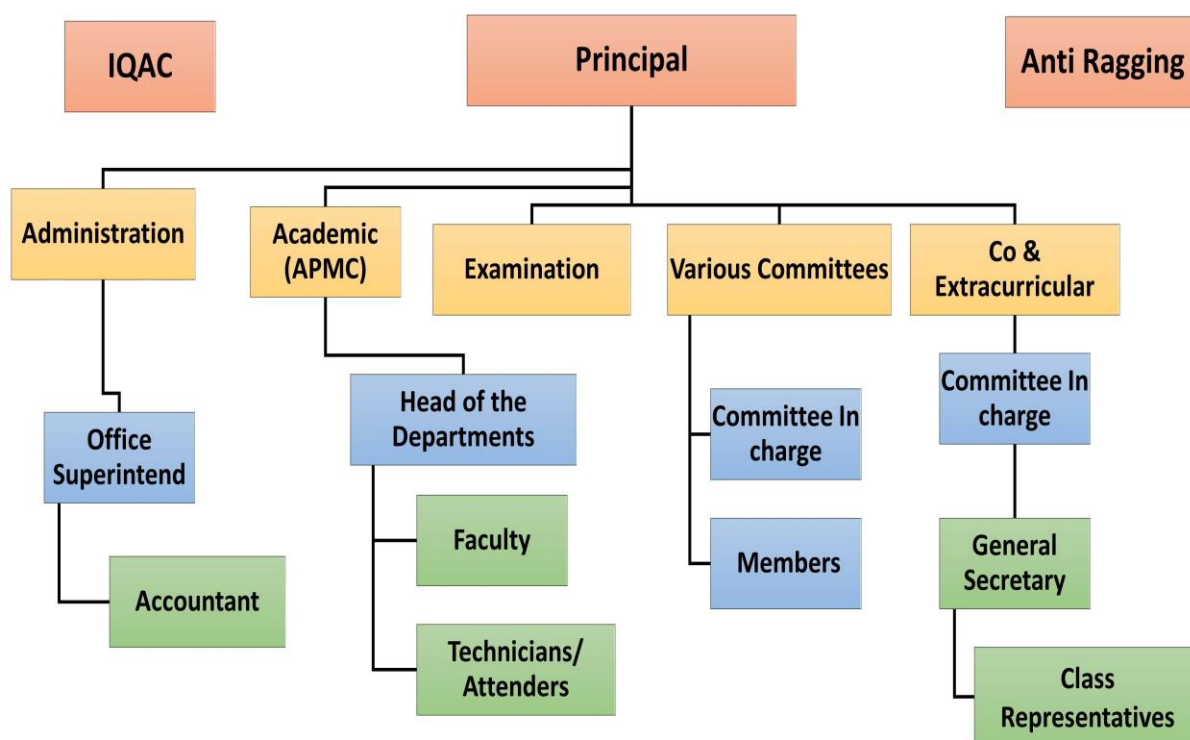

Decentralization of Work:

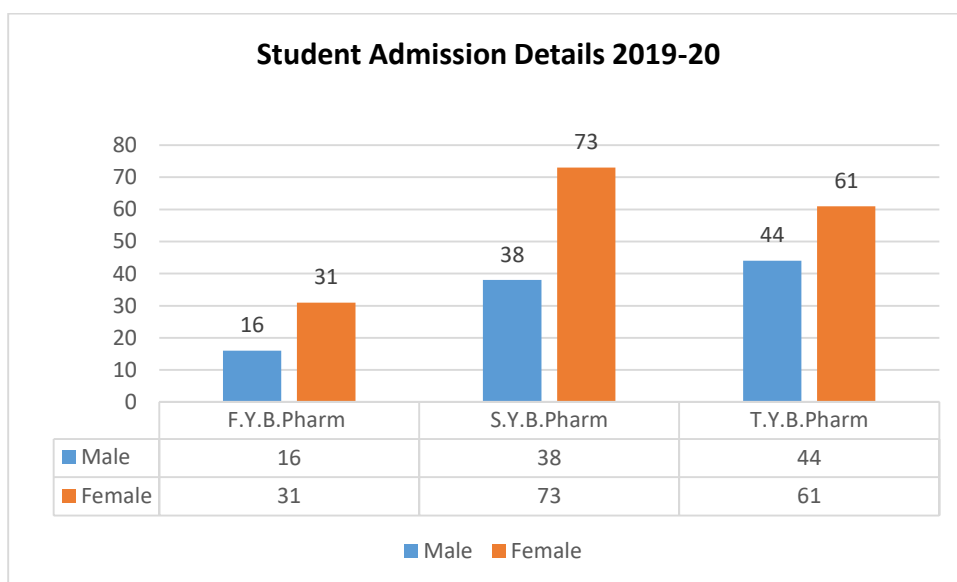

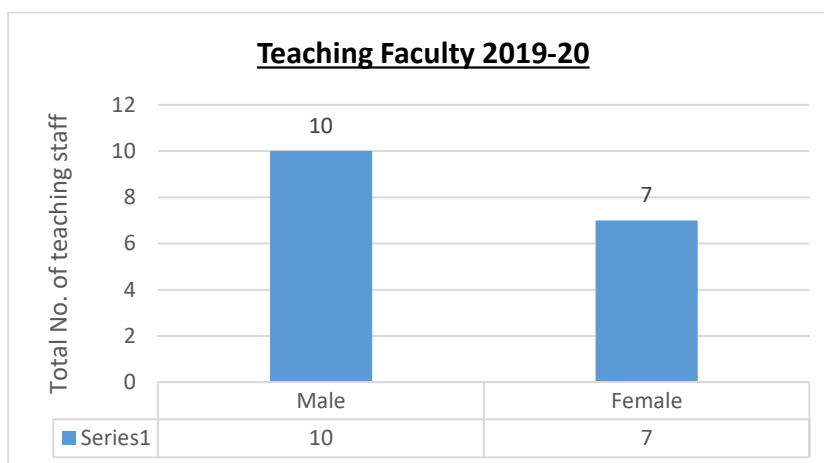
TEACHING FACULTY

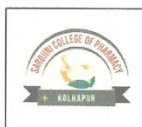
Teaching Faculty Information:

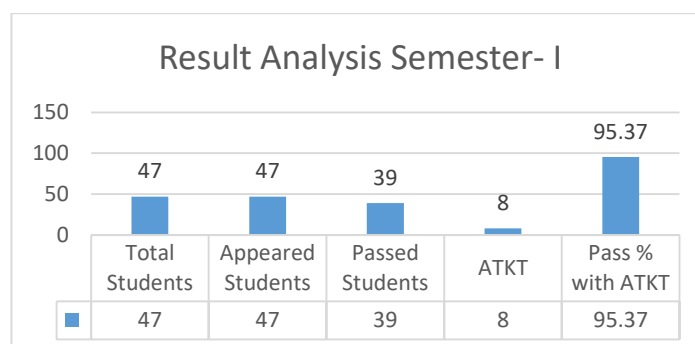


Students Performance

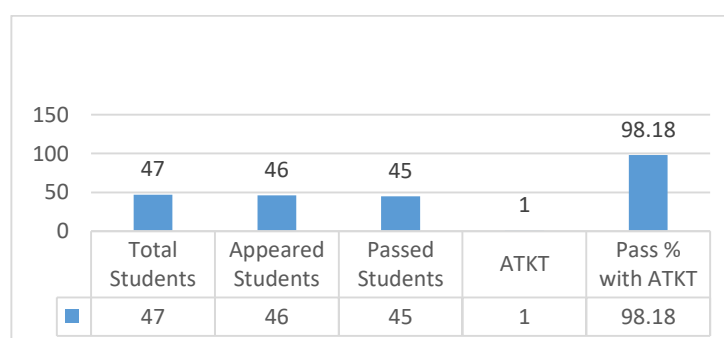

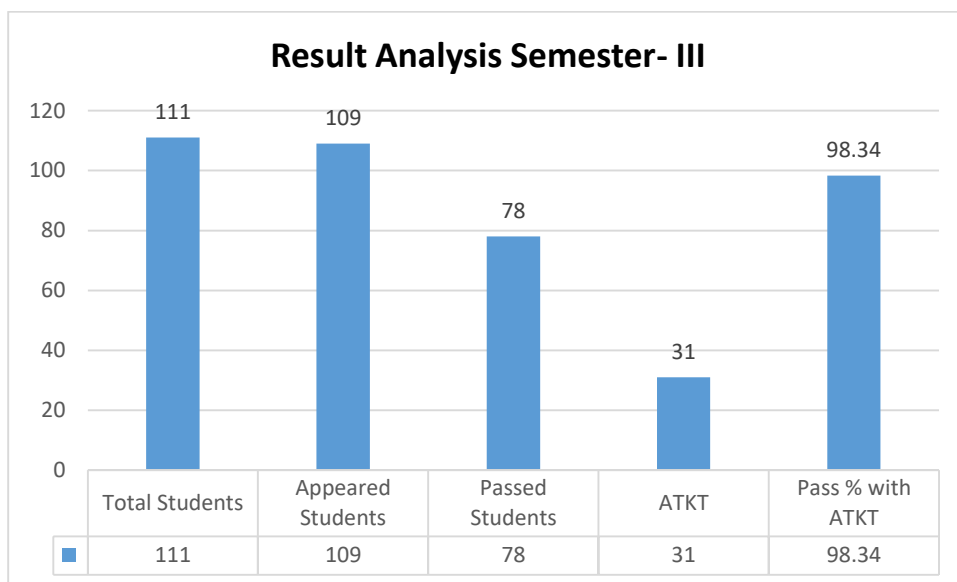
RESULT ANALYSIS SEMESTER- II

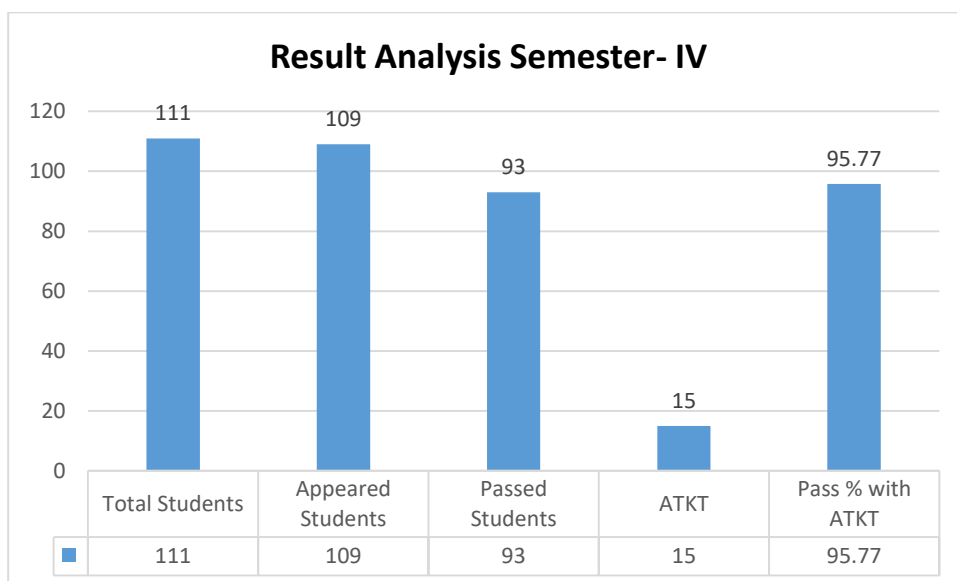
