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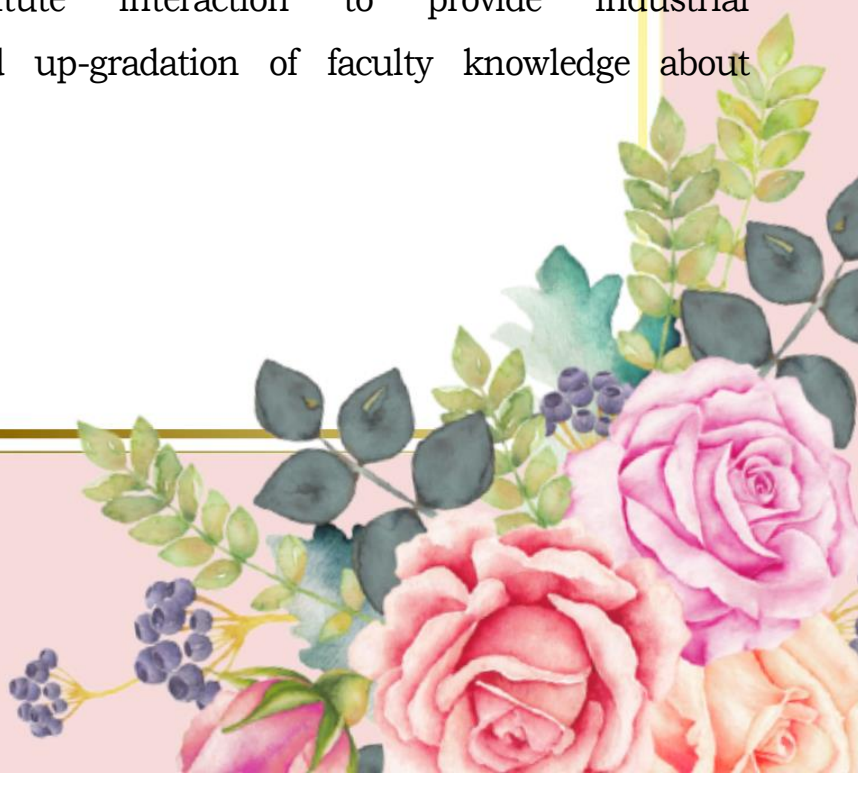

I shall follow the system which I consider best for pharmaceutical of patients.

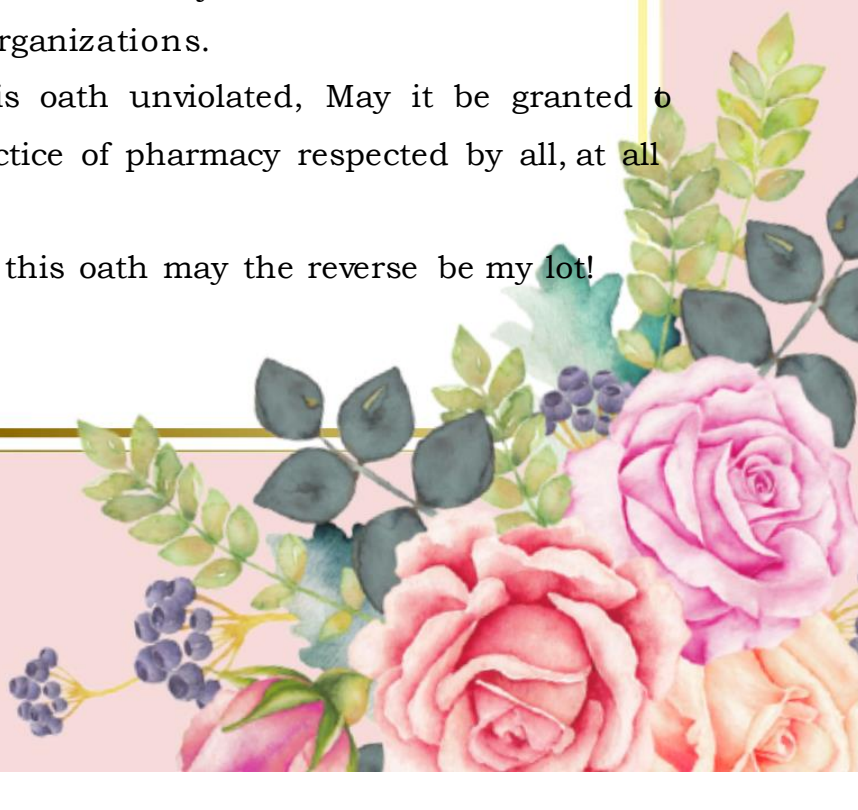
I shall Endeavour to discover and manufacture drugs of quality to alleviate sufferings of humanity.

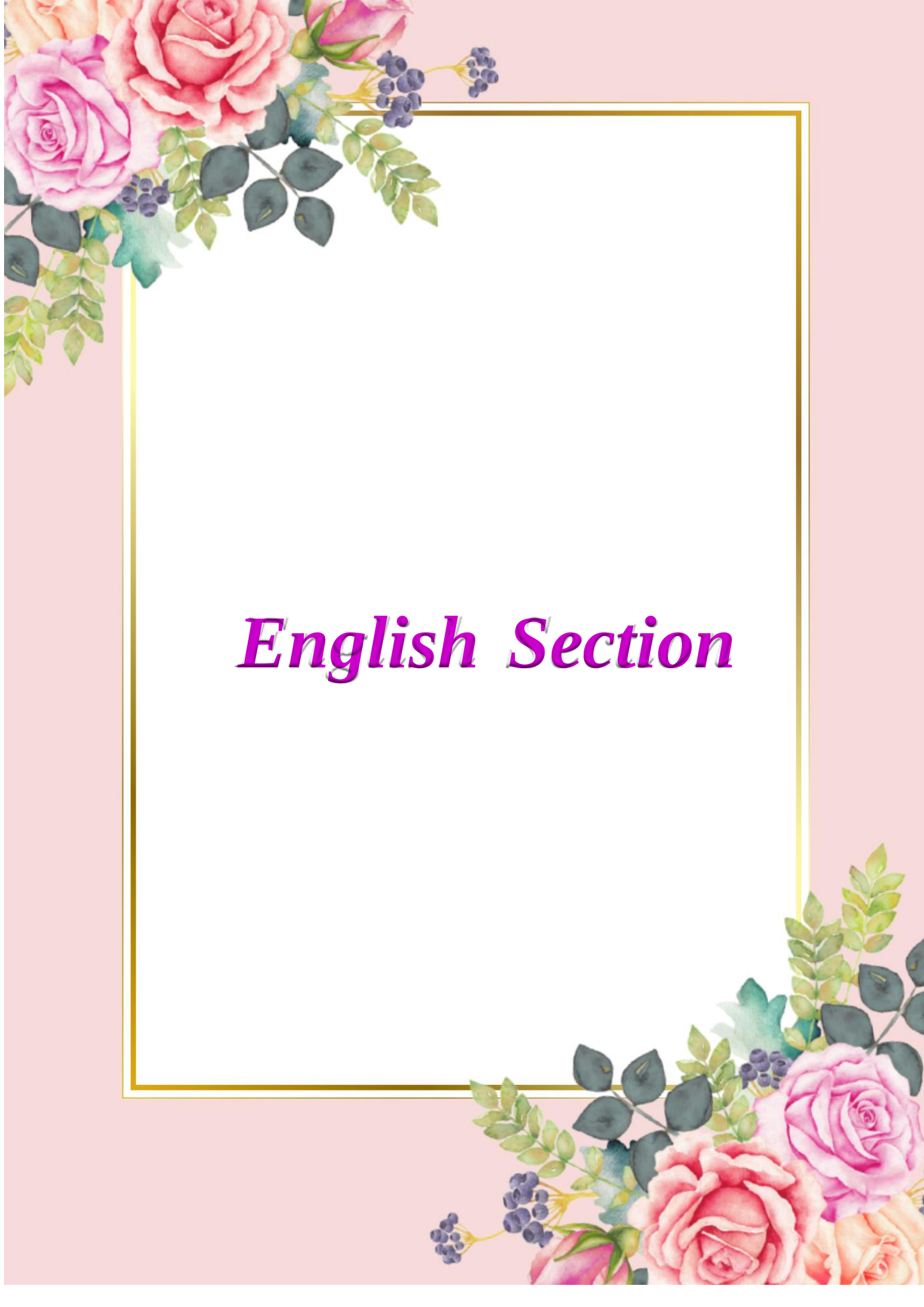

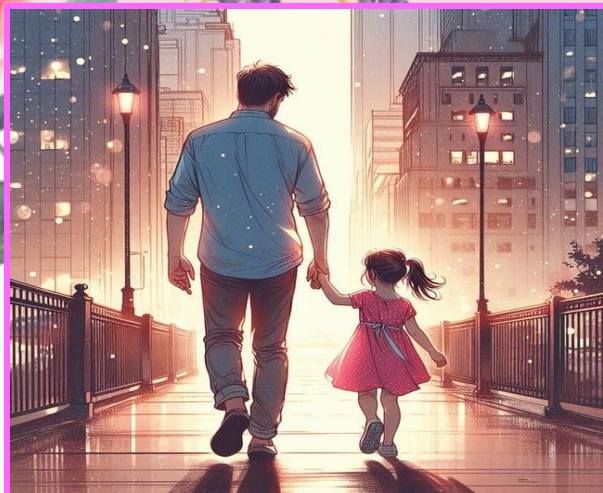

Kathak: From Temples to Global Stages

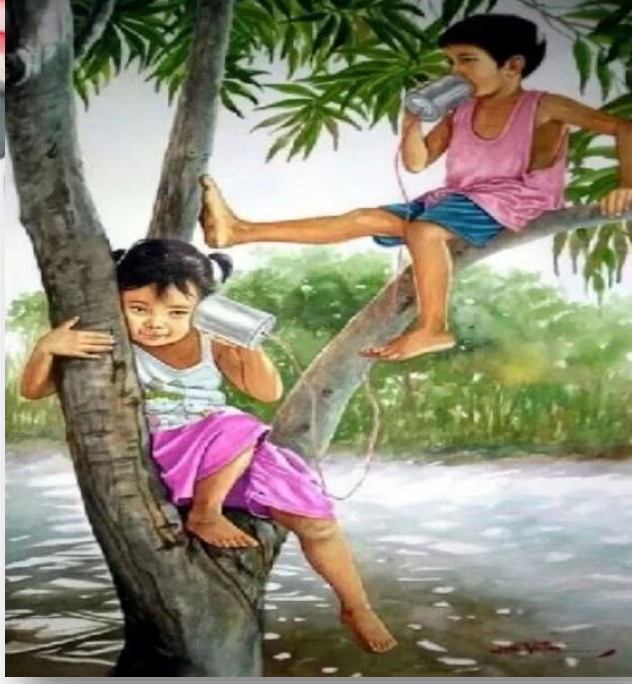
Kathak is a classical dance form from Uttar Pradesh. Kathak dance has a traditional and cultural heritage that gives it the status of the Indian classical dance form. The technical and aesthetic aspects associated with Kathak have been passed onto generations verbally as an oral tradition. Like the majority of the art forms of India, Kathak thrives on the Guru-Shishya Parampara or the teacher-disciple tradition. The term Kathak is derived from the Vedic Sanskrit word 'Katha' which means "story", and Kathakar which means "the one who tells a story". Wandering Kathakars or the traveling bards conveyed tales, inspired by our ancient epics and mythologies, through dance, songs, and music. Kathak performers exhibit stories through graceful hand movements, extensive footwork, flexible body movements, and most importantly intense facial expressions capable of evoking a range of emotions. Kathak evolved during the Bhakti movement and incorporated stories revolving around the Hindu deity Krishna and his childhood. Kathak evolved as an expression of devotion towards Lord Krishna. Studies suggest that Kathak originated in Varanasi and this dance form traveled through Lucknow, Jaipur, and other parts of North and North West India. The Lucknow tradition of Kathak believes that Lord Krishna appeared in the dream of his devotee, named Ishwari. He instructed her to develop dance as a form of worship, in her dream. Ishwari developed Kathak as a dance form and through her descendants preserved the learning and development, yielding the Lucknow Gharana of Kathak. Kathak in the Bhakti movement era revolved around the theme which portrayed the immortal love between Radha, Krishna, and the milkmaids (Gopis).

Drug Summery

Cinnamon



Cinnamon is a spice obtained from the inner bark of several tree species from the genus *Cinnamomum*. Cinnamon is used mainly as an aromatic condiment and flavouring additive in a wide variety of cuisines, sweet and savoury dishes, breakfast cereals, snack foods, bagels, teas, hot chocolate and traditional foods. The aroma and flavour of cinnamon derive from its essential oil and principal component, cinnamaldehyde, as well as numerous other constituents including eugenol. Cinnamon is rich in antioxidants and other beneficial compounds. Some research suggests that it may help you manage blood sugars, protect against heart disease, and reduce inflammation. Cinnamon has a long history of use in traditional medicine in various parts of the world, including China, India, and Persia (Iran). Today, cinnamon is promoted as a dietary supplement for diabetes or for irritable bowel syndrome or other gastrointestinal problems, as well as other conditions. Cassia cinnamon is promoted for topical use (application to the skin) as an insect repellent. It can help smooth skin texture and remove dead skin cells so that your complexion appears brighter and more even-toned. Cinnamon's antiseptic properties are also known to clear pores, therefore giving your skin a natural glow. Cinnamon sticks can impart flavor to a dish or sauce during the cooking process and then be discarded before serving. Ground cinnamon can be mixed into foods or sprinkled atop baked goods, desserts, savory dishes, and beverages. Used sparingly, cinnamon extract can liven all manner of dishes. The possibilities are endless!

Community pharmacy, also known as retail pharmacy, is the most common type of pharmacy that allows the public access to their medications and advice about their health. Traditionally known as a chemist, it is the healthcare facility that is responsible for the provision of pharmaceutical service to a specific community group or region. Most community pharmacies have a commercial store with a combination of medicinal goods only available with a prescription and those with that can be purchased over-the-counter. Community pharmacists are considered to be the most accessible health professional to the public, as they are available to provide personalized advice about health and medicine on a walk-in basis, without the need for an appointment. 89% of the population in the United Kingdom can access a community pharmacy within a 20-minute walk. Traditionally, the role of the community pharmacist is to provide medications to patients based on a prescription from their doctor. However, the role of the pharmacist has evolved greatly and is now deeply involved in a number of other health initiatives.

The many tasks of a community pharmacist may include:

- Processing prescriptions: checking the prescription from the doctor and preparing the medication for the patient.
- Checking for drug interactions: making sure that the medications and doses are appropriate for the patient considering health factors and other medications.
- Dispensing medications: labeling the medication correctly with instructions for the patient about how to take the medication.
- Disposing of medication: taking unneeded medications from patients and disposing of them safely.
- Providing advice: helping patients to understand their health and medicines and giving appropriate advice.
- Promotion of healthy lifestyle: supporting patients to make healthier choices, such as eating more nutritious food, exercising more often or stopping smoking.

OTC Products



Over-the-counter (OTC) medicines are drugs you can buy without a prescription. OTC drugs enable people to relieve many annoying symptoms and to cure some diseases simply and without the cost of seeing a doctor. However, safe use of these drugs requires knowledge, common sense, and responsibility. In addition to the substances such as aspirin and acetaminophen that people typically think of as OTC drugs, many other commonly available products are considered OTC drugs by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA). Some toothpastes, some mouthwashes, some types of eye drops, wart removers, first aid creams and ointments that contain antibiotics, and even dandruff shampoos are considered OTC drugs. Each country establishes which drugs are available OTC in that country. Some OTC drugs were originally available only by prescription. After many years of use under prescription regulation, drugs with excellent safety records may be approved by the FDA for over-the-counter sale. The analgesic ibuprofen and the heartburn remedy famotidine are examples of such drugs. Often, the OTC version has a substantially lower amount of active ingredient in each tablet, capsule, or caplet than does the prescription drug. When establishing appropriate doses of OTC drugs, manufacturers and the FDA try to balance safety and effectiveness. OTC drugs are not always better tolerated than similar prescription drugs. For example, the OTC sleep aid diphenhydramine can cause adverse effects that are just as serious as those associated with many prescription sleep aids, especially in older people.

❖ **The guidelines for choosing and using OTC drugs are as follows:**

- Make sure that the self-diagnosis is as accurate as possible. Do not assume the problem is “something that is going around.”
- Choose a product because the ingredients are appropriate for the condition, not because the product has a familiar brand name.
- Choose a product with the fewest appropriate ingredients. Products that attempt to relieve every possible symptom are likely to expose people to unnecessary drugs, pose additional risks, and cost more.
- Read the label carefully to determine the correct dose and precautions, including what conditions would make the drug a poor choice.
- When in doubt, ask a pharmacist or doctor what the most appropriate ingredient or product is.
- Ask a pharmacist to check for potential interactions with other drugs being used.
- Ask a pharmacist to identify possible side effects.
- Do not take more than the recommended dose.
- Do not take an over-the-counter drug longer than the maximum time suggested on the label. Stop taking the drug if symptoms worsen.
- Keep all drugs, including over-the-counter drugs, out of the reach of children.

If you have been taking an OTC medicine but your symptoms don't go away, contact your health care provider. You should not take OTC medicines longer or in higher doses than the label recommends.

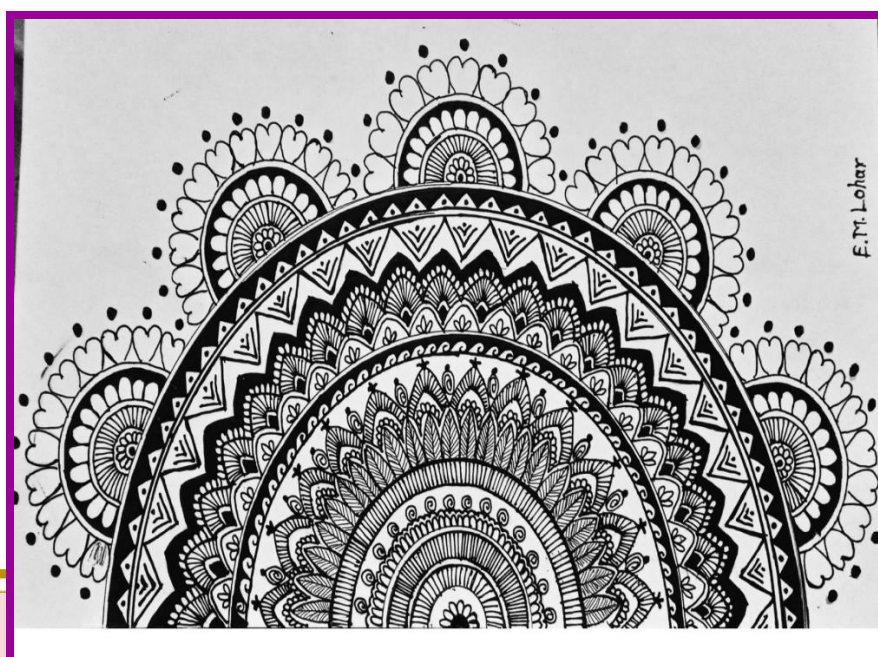

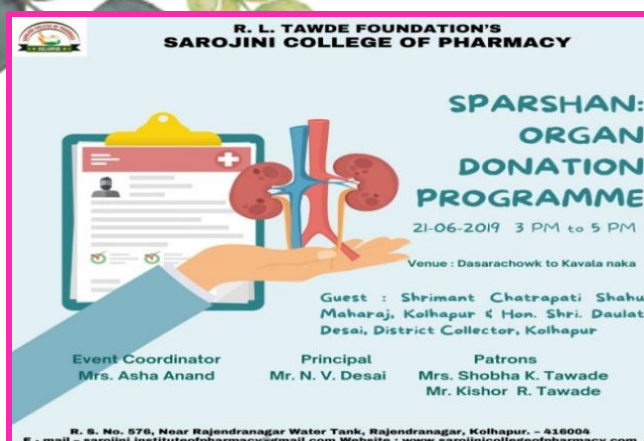

SPARSHAN: FELICITATION PROGRAMME IN HONOR OF ORGAN DONORS

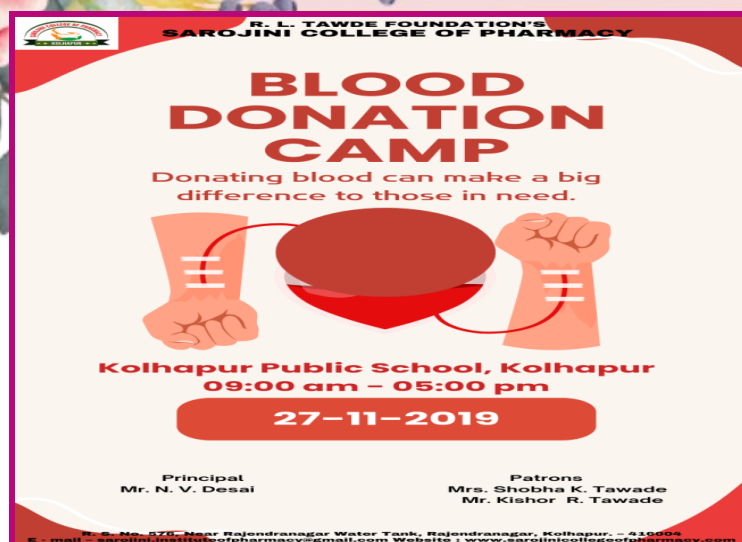

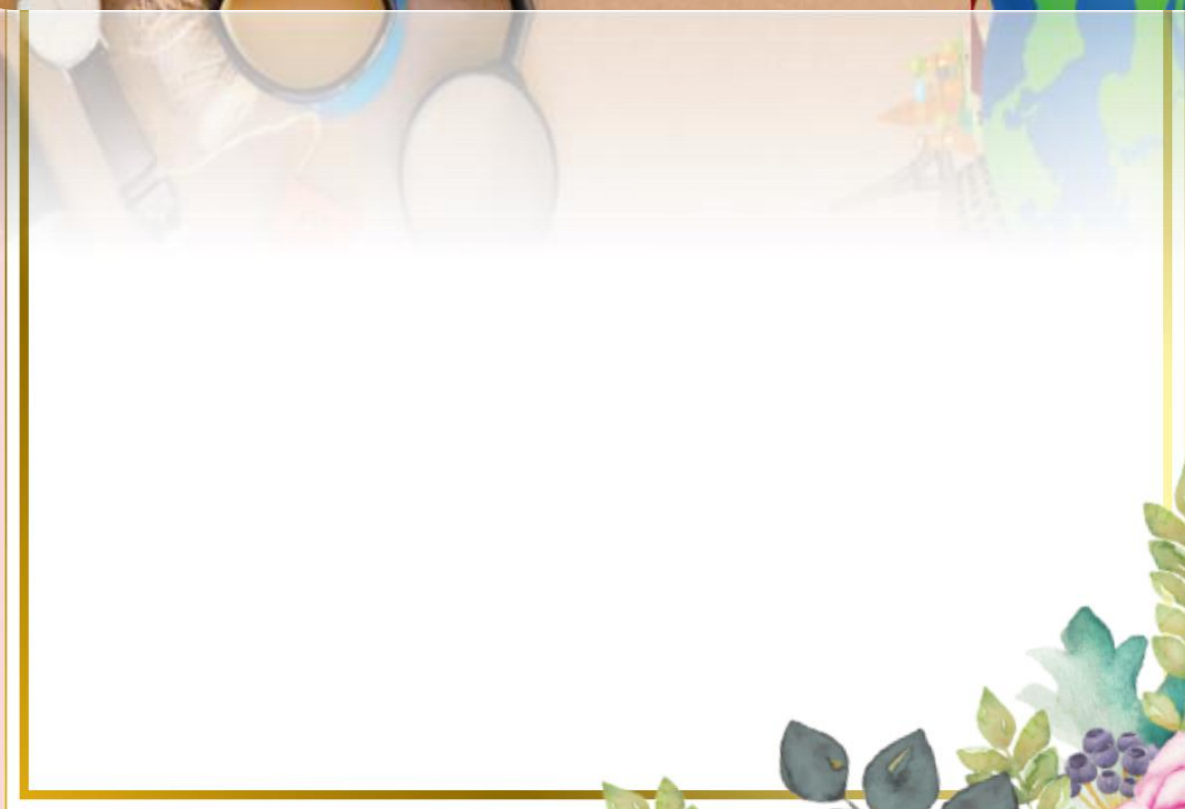

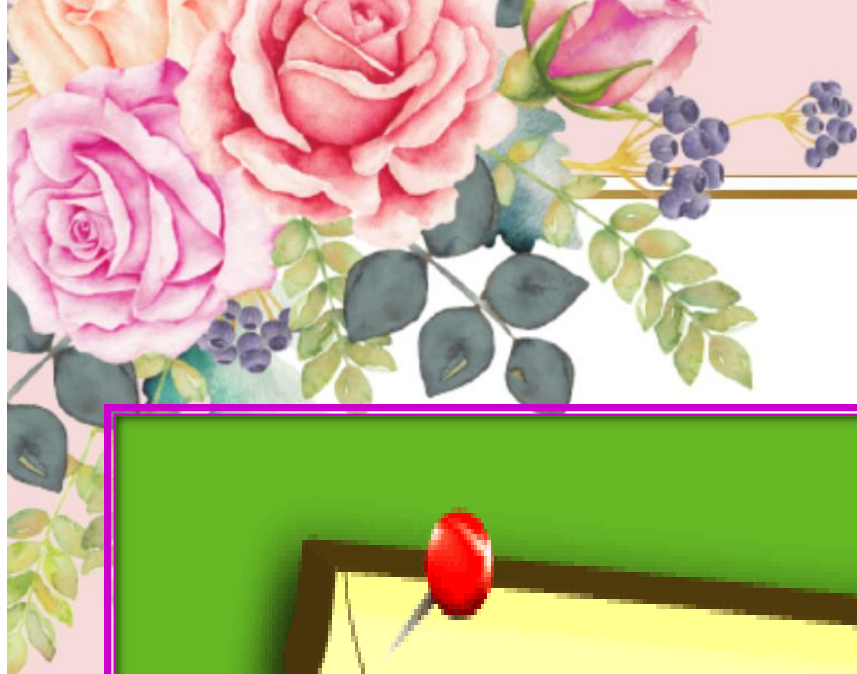


Annual Sports Week

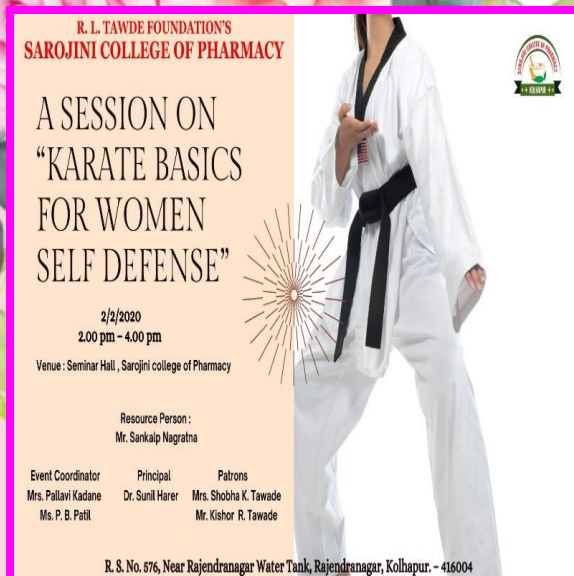

A SESSION ON "KARATE BASICS FOR WOMEN SELF DEFENSE"

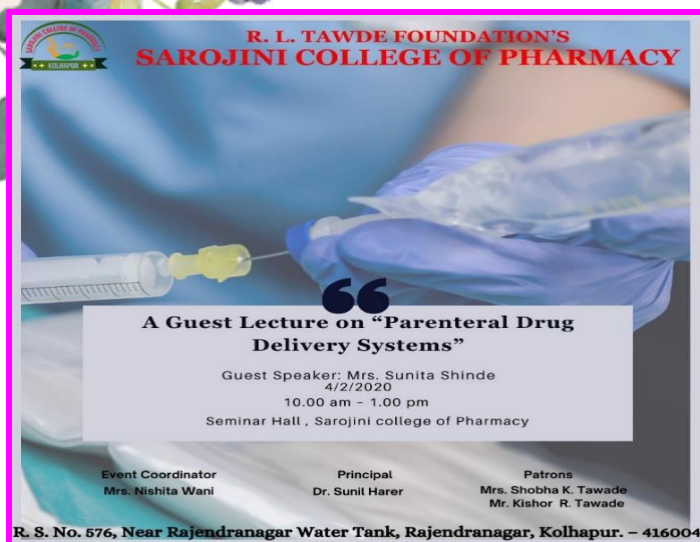

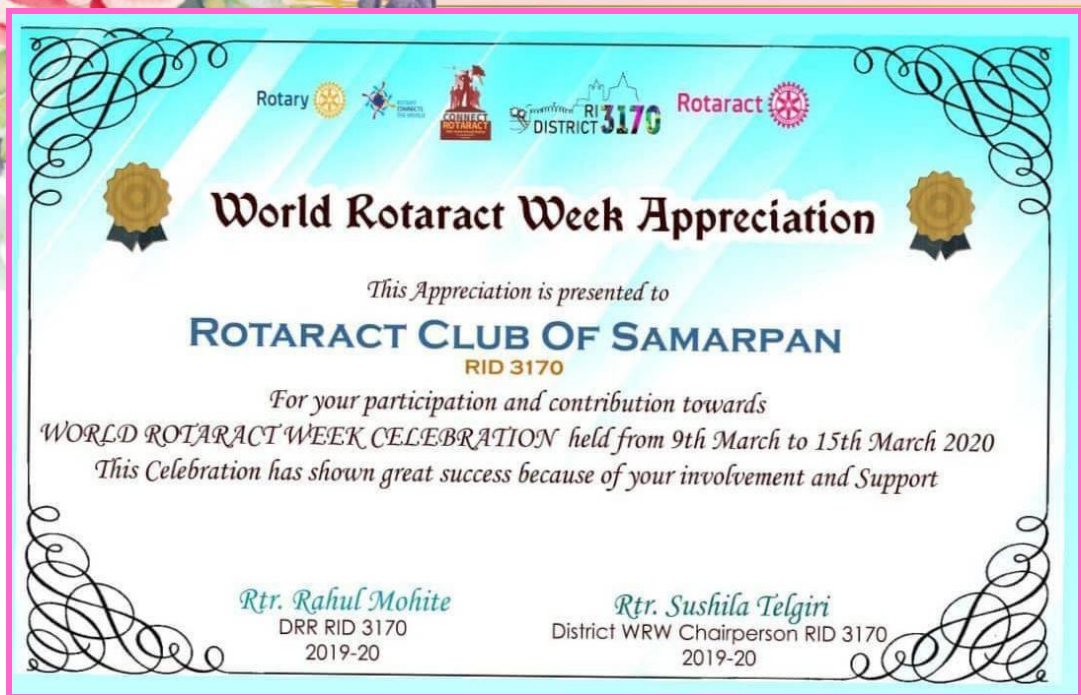

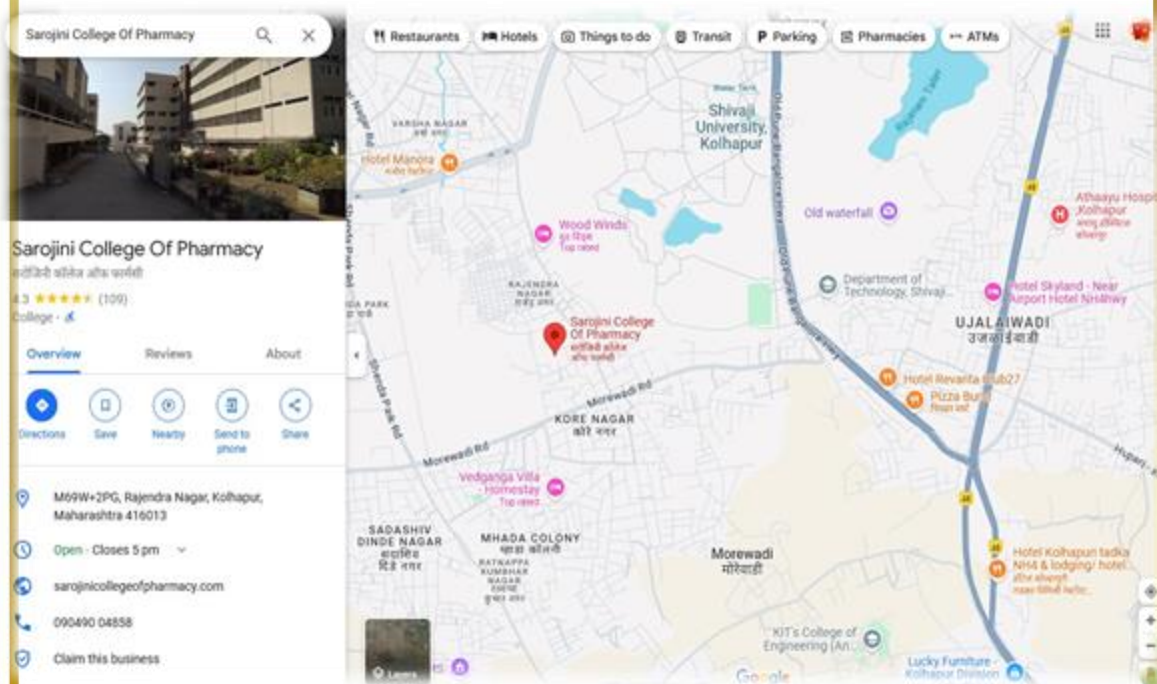
