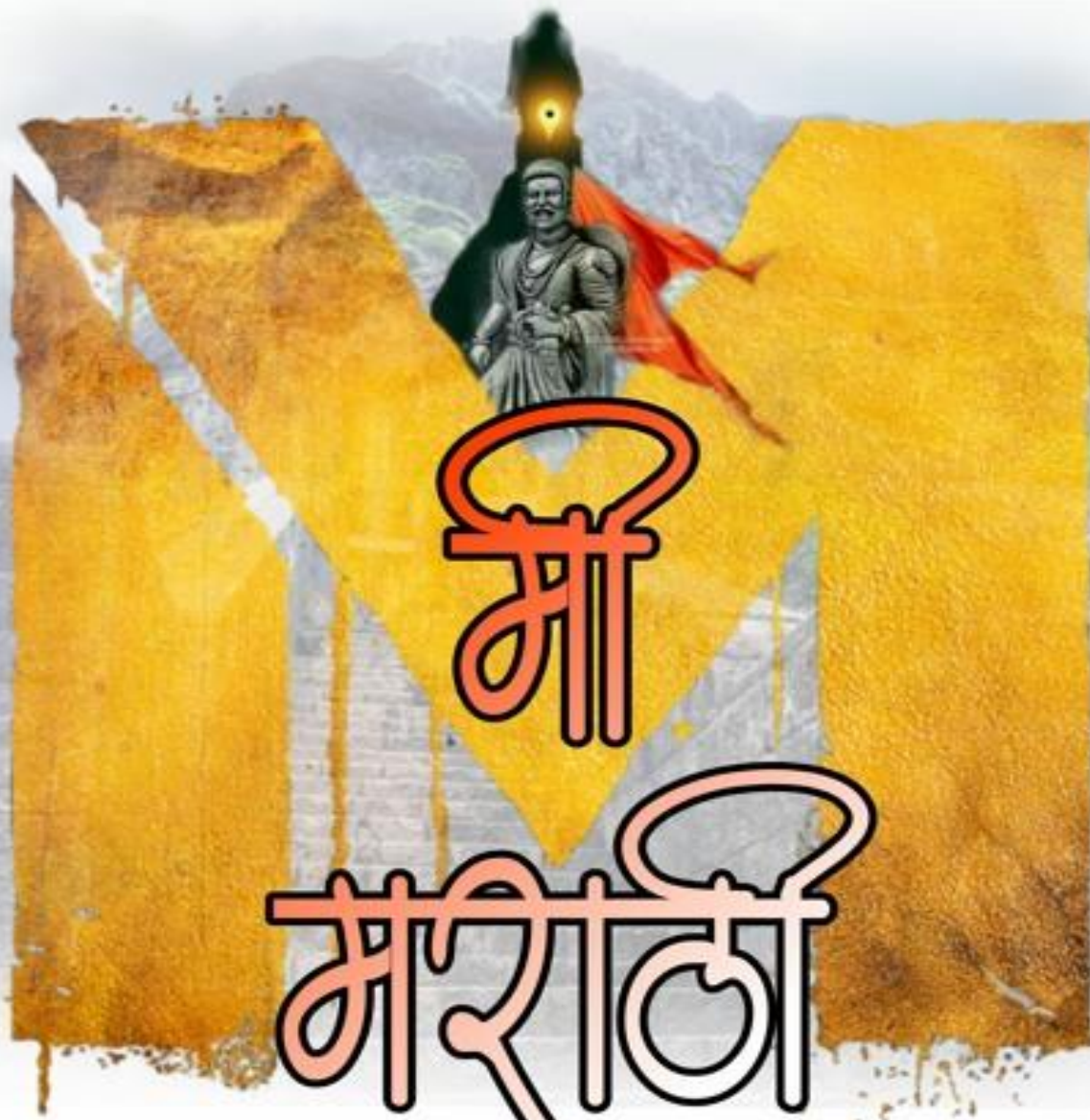

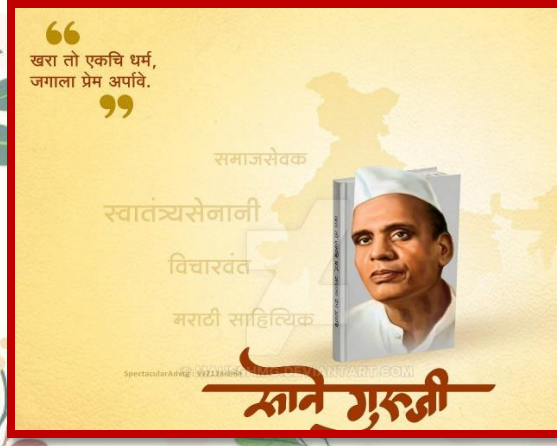

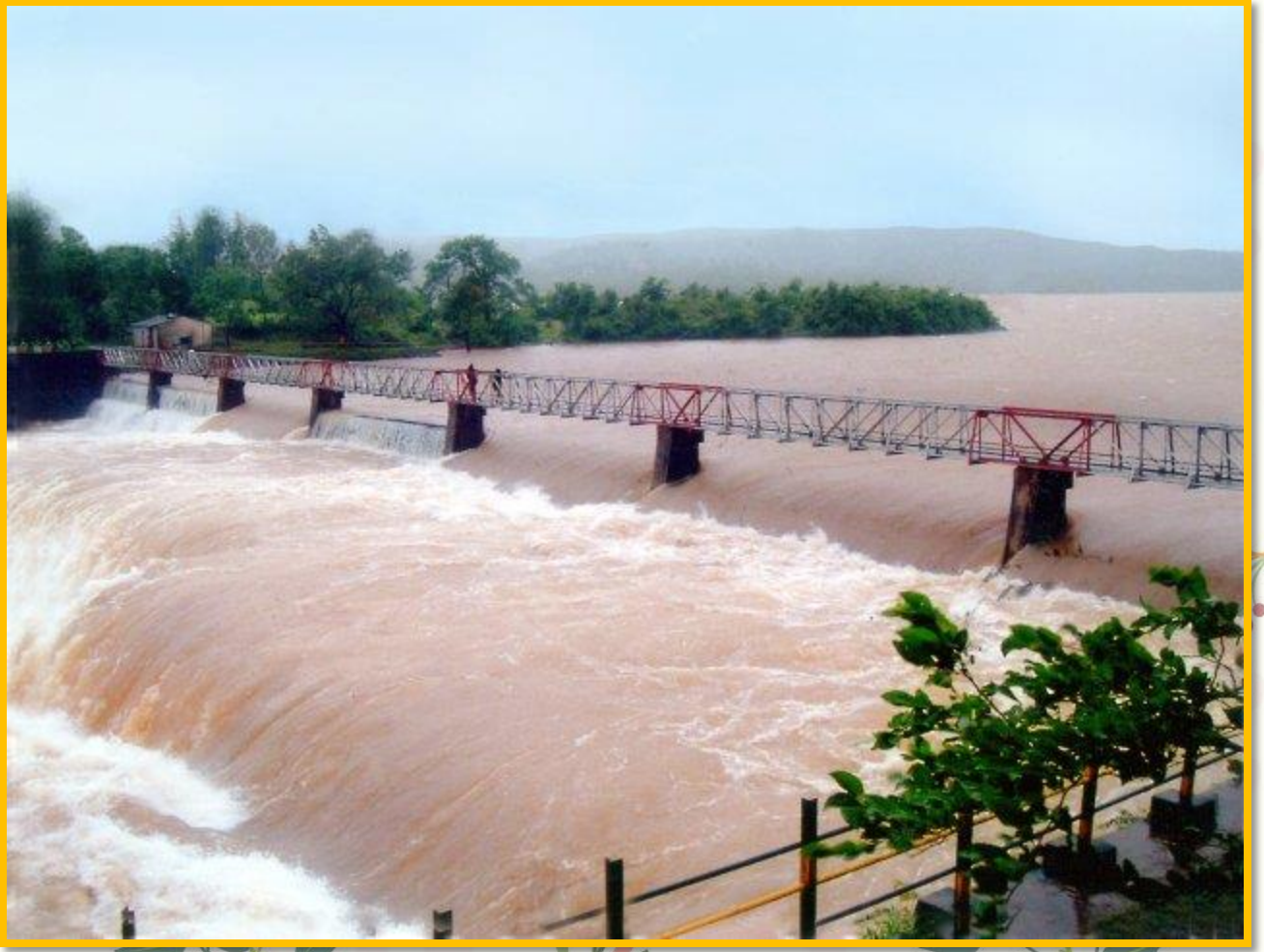


शाहू महाराजांचा जन्म २६ जून इ.स. १८७४ रोजी कागल येथील घाटगे घराण्यात झाला. त्यांचे मूळ नाव यशवंत, त्यांच्या वडिलांचे नाव जयसिंगराव (आप्पासाहेब) तर आईचे नाव राधाबाई होते. कोल्हापूर संस्थानाचे राजे चौथे शिवाजी महाराज यांच्या मृत्यूनंतर त्यांच्या पत्नी आनंदीबाई यांनी १७ मार्च १८८४ रोजी यशवंतरावांना दत्तक घेतले, व 'शाहू' हे नाव ठेवले. सन १८८९ ते १८९३ या चार वर्षांच्या कालखंडात धारवाड येथे शाहू महाराजांचा शैक्षणिक आणि शारीरिक विकास झाला. शिक्षण चालू असतानाच १ एप्रिल १८९१ रोजी बडोद्याच्या गुणाजीराव खानविलकर यांच्या लक्ष्मीबाई या मुलीशी शाहू विवाहबद्ध झाले. या वेळी त्यांचे वय १७ वर्षांचे होते आणि लक्ष्मीबाई वय १२ वर्षांहून कमी होते. [५] २ एप्रिल १८९४ रोजी त्यांचा राज्यारोहण समारंभ झाला. राज्याभिषेक झाल्यानंतर इ.स. १९२२ सालापर्यंत म्हणजे २८ वर्षे ते कोल्हापूर संस्थानाचे राजे होते राजर्षी शाहू हे खरे लोकशाहीवादी आणि समाजसुधारक मानले जातात. शाहू महाराज हे एक सक्षम राज्यकर्ते होते. त्यांच्या राजवटीत शाहू महाराजांनी अनेक पुरोगामी धोरणे यशस्वीपणे राबवली. १८९४ मधील त्यांच्या राज्याभिषेकापासून ते १९२२ मध्ये त्यांच्या निधनापर्यंत त्यांनी राज्यातील मागास जातींतील लोकांसाठी काम केले. जात-पंथाची पर्वा न करता सर्वांना प्राथमिक शिक्षण देणे हे त्यांचे सर्वात महत्वाचे प्राधान्य होते. ब्रिटिश राजसत्तेच्या काळामध्ये सामान्य जनतेला न्याय मिळवून देण्यासाठी व बहुजन समाजाच्या सामाजिक उन्नतीसाठी या काळात शाहू राजांनी प्रयत्न केले, सामाजिक परिवर्तनाला गती प्राप्त करून दिली, तसेच सनातनी वर्गाच्या विरोधाला न जुमानता दलित (अस्पृश्य) व मागासवर्गीय समाजाच्या विकासासाठी महत्वाची भूमिका बजावली. महाराजांना "राजर्षी" ही पदवी त्यांच्या राज्यभिषेकाच्या वेळी त्यांना त्यांच्या क्षात्र गुरुने दिली. महाराष्ट्राला तीन प्रमुख समाजसुधारकांचा वैचारिक वारसा लाभला असल्यामुळे या राज्यास "फुले-शाहू-आंबेडकरांचा महाराष्ट्र" असे म्हणतात. शाहू महाराजांनी बहुजन समाजात शिक्षणप्रसार करण्यावर विशेष भर दिला. त्यांनी कोल्हापूर संस्थानात प्राथमिक शिक्षण सक्तीचे व मोफत केले. स्त्री शिक्षणाचा प्रसार व्हावा म्हणून त्यांनी राजाज्ञा काढली. अस्पृश्यता नष्ट करण्याच्या दृष्टीने त्यांनी इ.स. १९१९ साली सवर्ण व अस्पृश्यांच्या वेगळ्या शाळा भरवण्याची पद्धत बंद केली. जातिभेद दूर करण्यासाठी त्यांनी आपल्या राज्यात आंतरजातीय विवाहाला मान्यता

देणारा कायदा केला. इ.स. १९१७ साली त्यांनी पुनर्विवाहाचा कायदा करून विधवाविवाहाला कायदेशीर मान्यता मिळवून दिली. बहुजन समाजाला राजकीय निर्णयप्रक्रियेत सामावून घेण्यासाठी त्यांनी इ.स. १९१६ साली निपाणी येथे 'डेक्कन रयत असोसिएशन' ही संस्था स्थापली. वेदोक्त मंत्र म्हणण्याच्या अधिकारावरून झालेले **वेदोक्त प्रकरण** शाहू महाराजांच्याच काळात झाले



डॉ. बाबासाहेब आंबेडकरांना त्यांच्या शिक्षणासाठी, तसेच मूकनायक वृत्तपत्रासाठी शाहू महाराजांनी सहकार्य केले. चित्रकार आबालाल रहिमान यांच्यासारख्या कलावंतांना राजाश्रय देऊन प्रोत्साहन दिले. शाहू महाराजांना 'राजर्षी' ही उपाधी कानपूरच्या कुर्मी क्षत्रिय समाजाने दिली. महाराजांनी सुमारे २८ वर्षे राज्यकारभार केला. २६ जुन हा शाहू महाराजांचा जन्म दिवस महाराष्ट्र शासनाने २००६ पासून "सामाजिक न्याय दिन" म्हणून साजरा करण्याचे घोषित केले आहे. शाहू महाराजांनी सरकारी नोकऱ्यांत मागास वर्गासाठी पन्नास टक्के जागा राखून ठेवण्याचा निर्णय घेतला, वाघ्या-मुर्ळी प्रतिबंधक कायदा केला. स्त्री पुनर्विवाह कायदा केला. आपल्या संस्थानात आंतरजातीय विवाहाला मान्यता देणारा कायदा केला तसेच त्यांनी स्वतः असे काही विवाह घडवून आणले. कोल्हापूर येथे "शाहपूरी" ही गुळाची बाजारपेठ सुरु केली. शाहूंनी निरनिराळ्या जातीच्या लोकांसाठी वस्तीगृहे सुरु केली. अस्पृश्यांसाठी "मिस क्लार्क" हे वस्तीगृह स्थापन केले. १५ टक्के शिष्यवृत्तीची घोषणा केली. महर्षी विठ्ठल रामजी शिंदे यांनी 'सर्वांगपूर्ण राष्ट्रपुरुष' अशा शब्दांत त्यांना गौरविलेले आहे.



राजर्षी शाहू महाराजांनी शंभर वर्षांपूर्वी सिंचनाचे महत्त्व ओळखून त्या कामाला सर्वाधिक प्राधान्य दिले. विहिरी, तलाव, छोटे बंधारे अशा अनेक योजनांचा धडाका लावला. राधानगरी धरण म्हणजे या प्रयत्नांच्या मालिकेतील मुकुटमणी आहे. एका छोट्या संस्थानाच्या बचतीमधून इ.स. १९०७ मध्ये शाहू महाराजांनी राधानगरी या धरणाच्या महत्त्वाकांक्षी प्रकल्पासाठी धरणाची योजना पुढे आणली. ९ फेब्रुवारी १९०८ला गाव नव्याने वसवून त्या गावाचे नाव "राधानगरी" ठेवण्यात आले. १९०९ मध्ये धरणाचे प्रत्यक्ष बांधकाम सुरू झाले. १९१८ पर्यंत धरणाचे बांधकाम ४० फुटांपर्यंत पूर्ण झाले. राधानगरी धरण कोल्हापूर जिल्ह्यातील एक धरण आहे. हे धरण भोगावती नदीवर बांधण्यात आले असून त्याचा उपयोग शेतीच्या पाणी पुरवठ्यासाठी व वीज निर्मितीसाठी होतो. महाराजांनी कोल्हापूर, बेळगाव या भागातील स्वातंत्र्यवीराना वेळोवेळी आर्थिक व इतर मदत केली. शाहू महाराज व भारतरत्न डॉ. बाबासाहेब आंबेडकर यांचे संबंध सर्वश्रुत आहे. डॉ. बाबासाहेबांनी 'मूकनायक' हे पाक्षिक ३१ जानेवारी १९२०ला प्रथम प्रकाशित केले. परंतु आर्थिक अडचणीमुळे पुढे ते बंद पडले. परंतु हे राजर्षी शाहू महाराजांच्या लक्षात आल्यावर त्यांनी तात्काळ २५०० रुपयांची भरघोस मदत केली. मुंबई येथे ६ मे १९२२ रोजी त्यांचे निधन झाले.

## Drug Review Turmeric



Turmeric is a common spice that comes from the root of *Curcuma longa*. It contains a chemical called curcumin, which might reduce swelling. Turmeric has a warm, bitter taste and is frequently used to flavor or color curry powders, mustards, butters, and cheeses. Because curcumin and other chemicals in turmeric might decrease swelling, it is often used to treat conditions that involve pain and inflammation. People commonly use turmeric for osteoarthritis. It is also used for hay fever, depression, high cholesterol, a type of liver disease, and itching, but there is no good scientific evidence to support most of these uses. There is also no good evidence to support using turmeric for COVID-19. Don't confuse turmeric with Javanese turmeric root or tree turmeric. Also, don't confuse it with zedoary or goldenseal, which are unrelated plants that are sometimes called turmeric. Turmeric has been used in Asia for centuries and is a major part of Ayurveda, Siddha medicine, traditional Chinese medicine, Unani, and the animistic rituals of Austronesian peoples. It was first used as a dye, and then later for its supposed properties in folk medicine. From India, it spread to Southeast Asia along with Hinduism and Buddhism, as the yellow dye is used to color the robes of monks and priests. Turmeric has also been found in Tahiti, Hawaii and Easter Island before European contact. There is linguistic and circumstantial evidence of the spread and use of turmeric by the Austronesian peoples into Oceania and Madagascar. The populations in Polynesia and Micronesia, in particular, never came into contact with India, but use turmeric widely for both food and dye. Thus independent domestication events are also likely.



### **What medications should you not take with turmeric?**

Turmeric can interact with other medications and supplements. People taking the following types should be cautious and contact a doctor before trying turmeric:

- blood-thinning medications, such as warfarin and clopidogrel
- blood-thinning supplements, such as angelica, clove, danshen, ginkgo, ginger, garlic, Panax ginseng, and willow
- antidiabetic medications, such as glyburide
- supplements that reduce blood glucose levels, such as fenugreek, guar gum, horse chestnut, psyllium, and eleuthero
- chemotherapy drugs, such as doxorubicin, cyclophosphamide, paclitaxel, and docetaxel
- medications metabolized by CYP450 enzymes
- hormone replacement therapy
- loratadine, losartan, midazolam, and verapamil
- norfloxacin
- statins
- sulfasalazine
- colchicine, a gout medication
- fezolinetant, a medication prescribed for menopausal hot flashes

## Indian Space Research Organisation



Indian Space Research Organisation ISRO is India's national space agency. It operates as the most principal research and development arm of the Department of Space (DoS), which is directly overseen by the Prime Minister of India, with the Chairman of ISRO also serving as the chief executive of the DoS. ISRO has the world's largest constellation of remote-sensing satellites and operates the GAGAN and IRNSS (NavIC) satellite navigation systems. It has sent three missions to the Moon and one to Mars. ISRO is primarily responsible for space-based operations, space exploration, international space cooperation and the development of related technologies. ISRO is one of the six government space agencies in the world that possess full launch capabilities, the ability to deploy cryogenic engines, the ability to launch extraterrestrial missions and the ability to operate a large fleet of artificial satellites. ISRO is also one of only four governmental space agencies in the world to have soft landing (unmanned) capabilities. In 1950, the Department of Atomic Energy (DAE) was founded with Bhabha as its secretary. It provided funding for space research throughout India. During this time, tests continued on aspects of meteorology and the Earth's magnetic field, a topic that had been studied in India since the establishment of the Colaba Observatory in 1823. In 1954, the Aryabhata Research Institute of Observational Sciences (ARIES) was established in the foothills of the Himalayas. The Rangpur Observatory was set up in 1957 at Osmania University, Hyderabad. Space research was further encouraged by the government of India. In 1957, the Soviet Union launched Sputnik 1 and opened up possibilities for the rest of the world to conduct a space launch.



As the national space agency of India, ISRO's purpose is the pursuit of all space-based applications such as research, reconnaissance, and communications. It undertakes the design and development of space rockets and satellites, and undertakes explores upper atmosphere and deep space exploration missions. ISRO has also incubated technologies in India's private space sector, boosting its growth India's economic progress has made its space programme more visible and active as the country aims for greater self-reliance in space technology. In 2008, India launched as many as 11 satellites, including nine from other countries, and went on to become the first nation to launch 10 satellites on one rocket. ISRO has put into operation two major satellite systems: the Indian National Satellite System (INSAT) for communication services, and the Indian Remote Sensing Programme (IRS) satellites for management of natural resources

#### **Academic**

Institutions like the Indira Gandhi National Open University and the Indian Institutes of Technology use satellites for educational applications. Between 1975 and 1976, India conducted its largest sociological programme using space technology, reaching 2,400 villages through video programming in local languages aimed at educational development via ATS-6 technology developed by NASA. This experiment—named Satellite Instructional Television Experiment (SITE)—conducted large-scale video broadcasts resulting in significant improvement in rural education

# Insulin

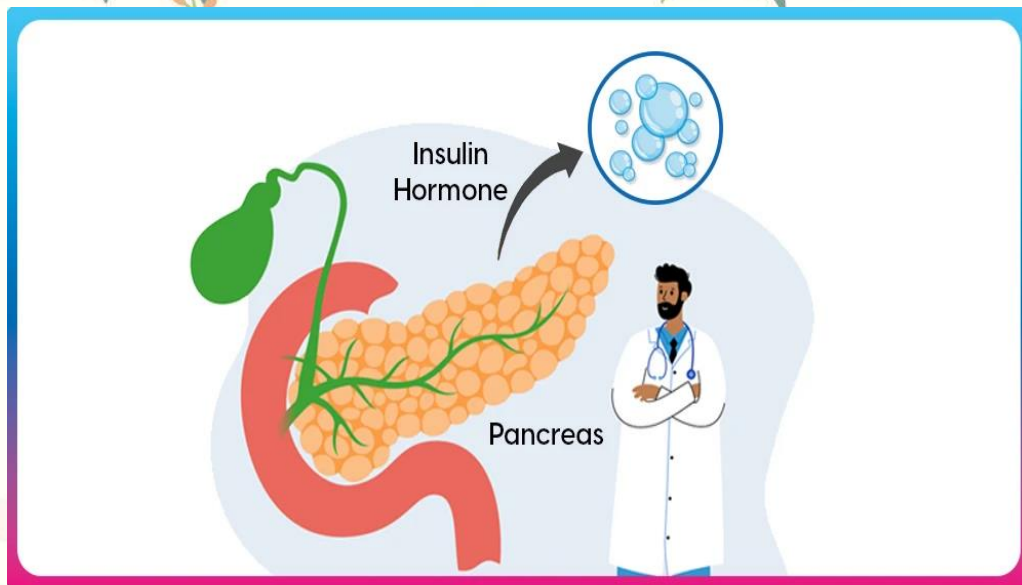


Insulin is a hormone made by an organ located behind the stomach called the pancreas. There are specialised areas within the pancreas called islets of Langerhans (the term insulin comes from the Latin insula that means island). The islets of Langerhans are made up of different type of cells that make hormones, the commonest ones are the beta cells, which produce insulin. Insulin is then released from the pancreas into the bloodstream so that it can reach different parts of the body. Insulin has many effects but mainly it controls how the body uses carbohydrates found in certain types of food. Carbohydrates are broken down by the human body to produce a type of sugar called [glucose](#). Glucose is the main energy source used by cells. Insulin allows cells in the muscles, liver and fat (adipose tissue) to take up this glucose and use it as a source of energy so they can function properly. Without insulin, cells are unable to use glucose as fuel and they will start malfunctioning. Extra glucose that is not used by the cells will be converted and stored as fat so it can be used to provide energy when glucose levels are too low. In addition, insulin has several other metabolic effects.

## How is insulin controlled?

The main actions that insulin has are to allow glucose to enter cells to be used as energy and to maintain the amount of glucose found in the bloodstream within normal levels. The release of insulin is tightly regulated in healthy people in order to balance food intake and the metabolic needs of the body. This is a complex process and other hormones found in the [gut](#) and pancreas also contribute to this blood glucose regulation. When we eat food, glucose is [absorbed](#) from our gut into the bloodstream, raising blood glucose levels. This rise in blood glucose causes insulin to

be released from the pancreas so glucose can move inside the cells and be used. As glucose moves inside the cells, the amount of glucose in the bloodstream returns to normal and insulin release slows down.



Insulin is a medication used in the treatment and management of diabetes mellitus type-1 and sometimes diabetes mellitus type-2, both of which are significant risk factors for coronary artery disease, stroke, peripheral vascular disease, and a host of other vascular conditions.

### • Pen

An insulin pen looks like a writing pen but has a needle for its point. Some insulin pens come filled with insulin and are disposable. Others have room for an insulin cartridge that you insert and replace after use. Many people find insulin pens easier to use, but they cost more than needles and syringes. You may want to consider using an insulin pen if you find it hard to fill the syringe while holding the vial or cannot read the markings on the syringe. Different pen types have features that can help with your injections. Some reusable pens have a memory function, which can recall dose amounts and timing. Other types of “connected” insulin pens can be programmed to calculate insulin doses and provide downloadable data reports, which can help you and your doctor adjust your insulin doses.

## HEALTH CHECK UP 2022

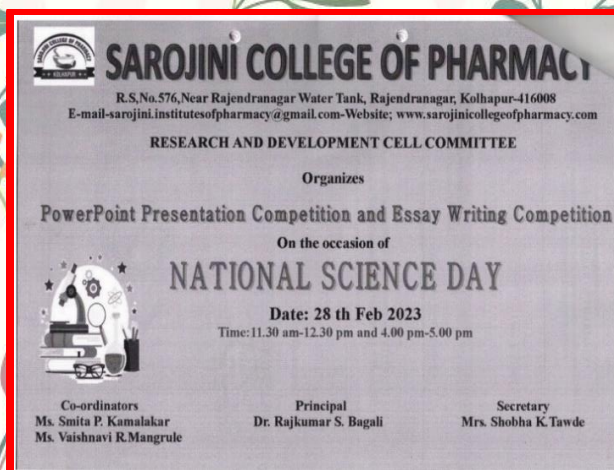

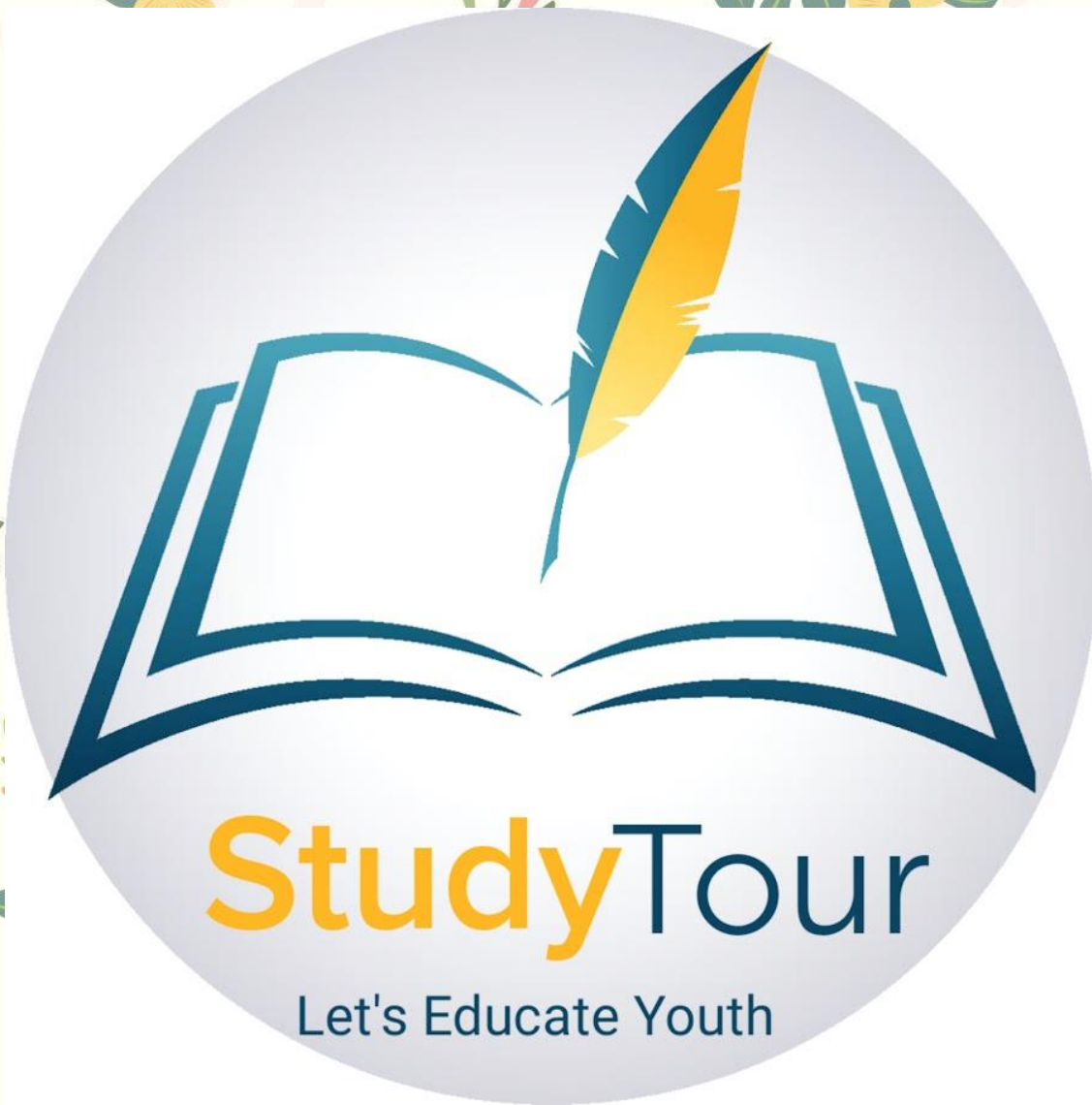
## Slogan Writing Competition

## Garbage treatment Plant Visit for First year D. Pharmacy Students

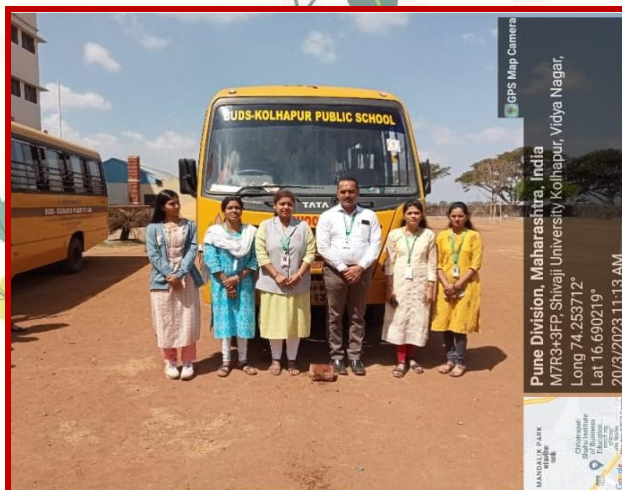

In the beginning, Mr. Hemant Kashid briefed the students about 100MLD Tertiary Sewage Treatment Plant. He has made this session interesting by asking basic questions to the students. After the introduction, all students were divided into two groups of batches and were headed by one staff member of the respective program who helped them to understand the processes going in the plant. Mr Hemant Kashid has explained the functions of each unit of a preliminary, primary, secondary, and tertiary process. He explained the mechanism of UASB (Up-flow Anaerobic Sludge Blanket) and nutrients removal process including Nitrification, De-Nitrification, and Phosphorous removal processes. Sewage treatment is the process of removing contaminants from municipal wastewater, containing mainly household sewage plus some industrial wastewater

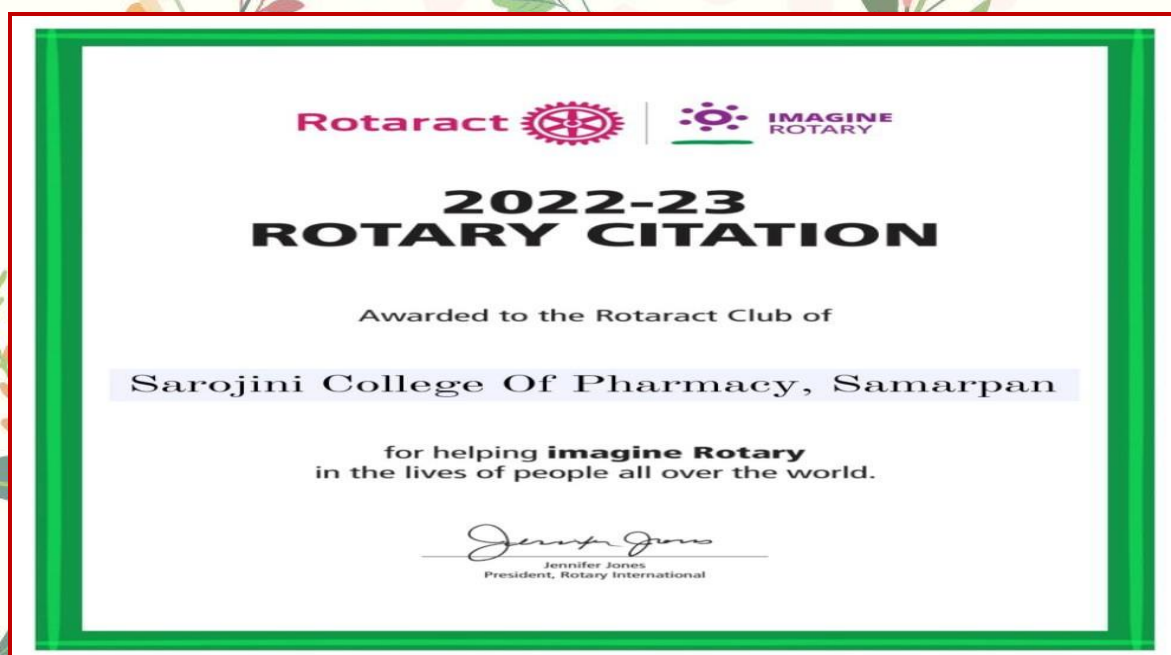

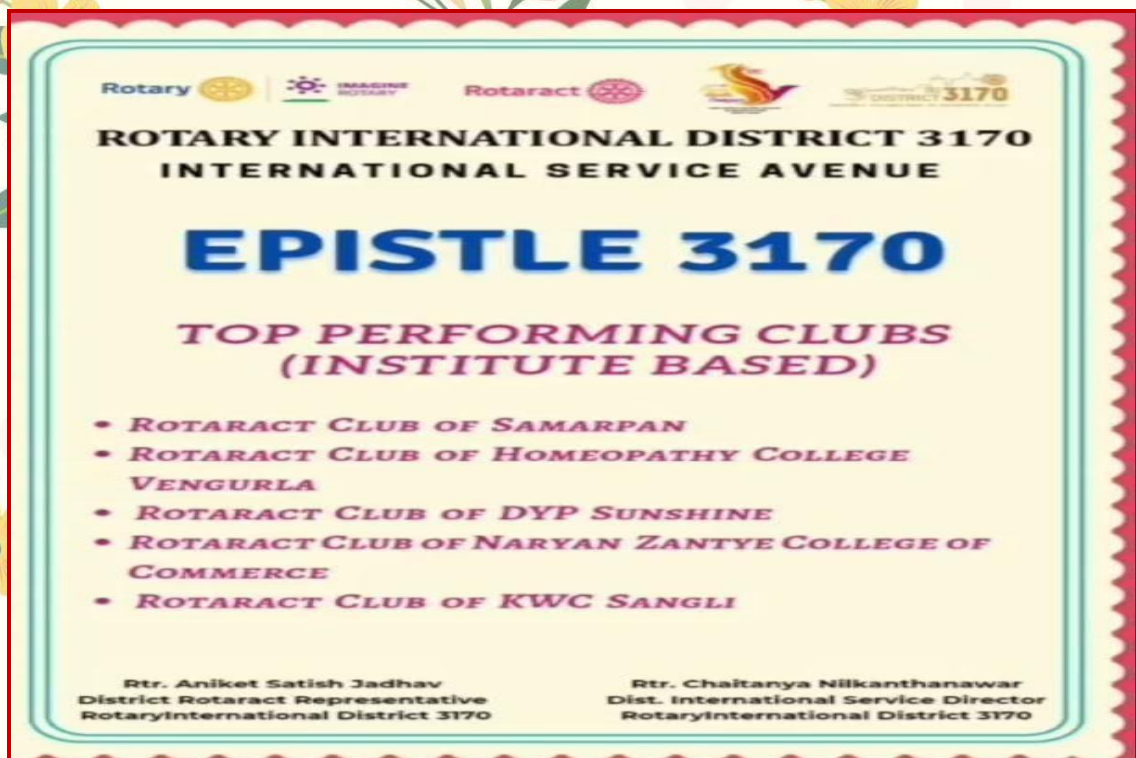

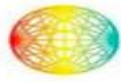
